



## **OFF-CAMPUS STUDY & EXCHANGES AND CAREER SERVICES INTERNATIONAL INTERNSHIPS**

Many students want to enhance an off-campus study experience by combining a study abroad with an international internship. When planning to do an internship abroad during the academic year, students must follow specific Off-Campus Study & Exchanges (OCSE) policies and procedures. Many of Skidmore College's approved off-campus study programs offer internship opportunities for academic credit (with departmental approval).
