Packing List

Below is a list of items we suggest you consider packing to make your stay more enjoyable.

- √ Bed linens are provided. This includes one pillow/pillowcase, two sheets, one thin blanket and one bath towel. We recommend you bring a warm blanket or comforter for cool nights. Bring a hand towel and washcloth, and extra towels especially if you plan to use the swimming pool.
- √ **Folding music stand – required for rehearsals and practices** (you may practice in your dorm room, anytime between 9am and 10pm)
- √ Dorm rooms have overhead lighting (you may want to bring a small portable reading lamp)
- √ Plug-in phone for dorm room. Local phone connection service is provided in dorm rooms, but the phone is not provided. You may choose to bring a cell phone instead.
- √ A sweater or light jacket for air-conditioned rooms on campus and for our evening at the Saratoga Performing Arts Center
- √ Concert dress attire will be nice summer wear, not formal
- √ Your own piccolo, alto and bass flutes which you may play in ensemble. Two altos and a bass will be provided.
- √ Music from the master class repertoire list is not required, but helpful to have. Also, remember to bring a notebook and pencil.
- √ Performances and classes will not be taped. You may bring your own tape or CD recorder and tape your own concert performances.
- √ Bug spray for the evening when we will visit the outdoor Saratoga Performing Arts Center to hear the Philadelphia Orchestra
- √ Money for snacks or breakfast at the Saratoga Race Track on Saturday morning. Breakfast at the Race Track is an optional event (approx. \$20.00 including tax and tip).
- √ Alarm clock
