The competition is open to students enrolled full-time in undergraduate or graduate programs who are nominated by their creative writing instructors. In 2008, the Institute awarded full tuition scholarships to more than thirty students from, among other institutions, Temple University, Brown University, Stanford University, Cleveland State University, Connecticut College, University of Rochester, University of Michigan, Sarah Lawrence, Yale University, Wellesley College, Washington University, University of Miami and Bennington College.

We are of course looking for particularly strong writers, and hope also to increase the diversity of our student body.

All faculty nominations and applications from students must be received BY MARCH 10th. Scholarships will be awarded by MARCH 20th. The names of scholarship award winners, along with their schools, will be announced to all applicants on or around MARCH 20th.
